Every year, around 3000 visitors discover the Salamander and its "Empower everyone, act for sustainable development" circuit. The tour is an accessible space dedicated to transparency and pedagogy. Built on three floors, it aims to give each visitor the keys to understanding the problems of ecology on a daily basis, recycling and energy management, using educational materials: films, panels, models, interactive game, virtual tour of the factory process... The visit is accompanied by a guide from SIVERT. 40 people maximum per group (possibility 2 groups subject)
